Age Divisions

Age Date: August 1, 2026

- 6U (non competitive)
- 8U
- 9-13
- 14-19

New Events

6U

- 6U Sled Roping
Replaces the Dummy Roping on foot

8U

- 8U Sled Roping
- 8U Double Mugging
- 8U Ribbon Roping

Rule Changes

- Bell collar catch for all Breakaway divisions **except 8U**
- 8U Breakaway remains a **catch-as-catch-can**.

Entry Fee Updates

- Team Roping – \$85.00
- Roping events – \$80.00

Work Point Buyout

COST: \$500 per semester

REMINDER: Members are only required to work 2 events per semester.

All Around Points

To qualify for the All Around, contestants must enter all eligible events at least nine (9) times during the season.

Example: If you enter Barrel Racing three times, those points will not count in All Around Standings.

Entering System

We will be using Equest to enter rodeos this year! Make sure you get your account created.
